Hello Church Family! As many of you know, I'm currently on a Sabbatical Leave (SL). This is a wonderful gift for me as a pastor of a small, strong congregation, and I would like to tell you how it is going. But first, I'd like to thank the leaders of our church council (the Leadership Team) for allowing this SL to occur. It has been a very renewing experience so far. So, how do I spend my time on SL? I fill my time with a number of life-giving activities. My primary job on this SL is to renew my relationship with God, which I seek to do through much time spent with Him in solitude and silence (reading God's Word, responding in prayer, and reading other books on spiritual formation). I've also done more journaling, which has been a helpful spiritual exercise. I've also spent more time exercising (cycling and running the natural trails of Lacombe), as I seek to renew my body. I'm also reading a few books on preaching right now, as I seek to grow in that very important area of ministry. Speaking of books, one particular book that I'm reading right now by Henry Blackaby called, *Experiencing God*, has been very formative. Through it I'm learning about the importance of developing an intimate relationship with God, so that I will be able to hear his voice and know and do his will. I highly recommend it to you! On June 11 I travel to Grand Rapids, MI., where I will participate in a seminar called, "Ministry to and With Millennials." My hope and prayer is that I will return with some tools that will help us be more fruitful in mentoring our young adults and youth for life and leadership in the church and community. Thank you all for your support in this ministry of rest and renewal. I pray for you regularly and I thank you for your prayers. It is a privilege to be your pastor, and I look forward to our ongoing joyful ministry partnership - through Jesus Christ our Lord.
