The writer of Psalm 103 loved God and wanted to praise Him for all His wonderful works. What are some of the good things that the psalmist said God does?

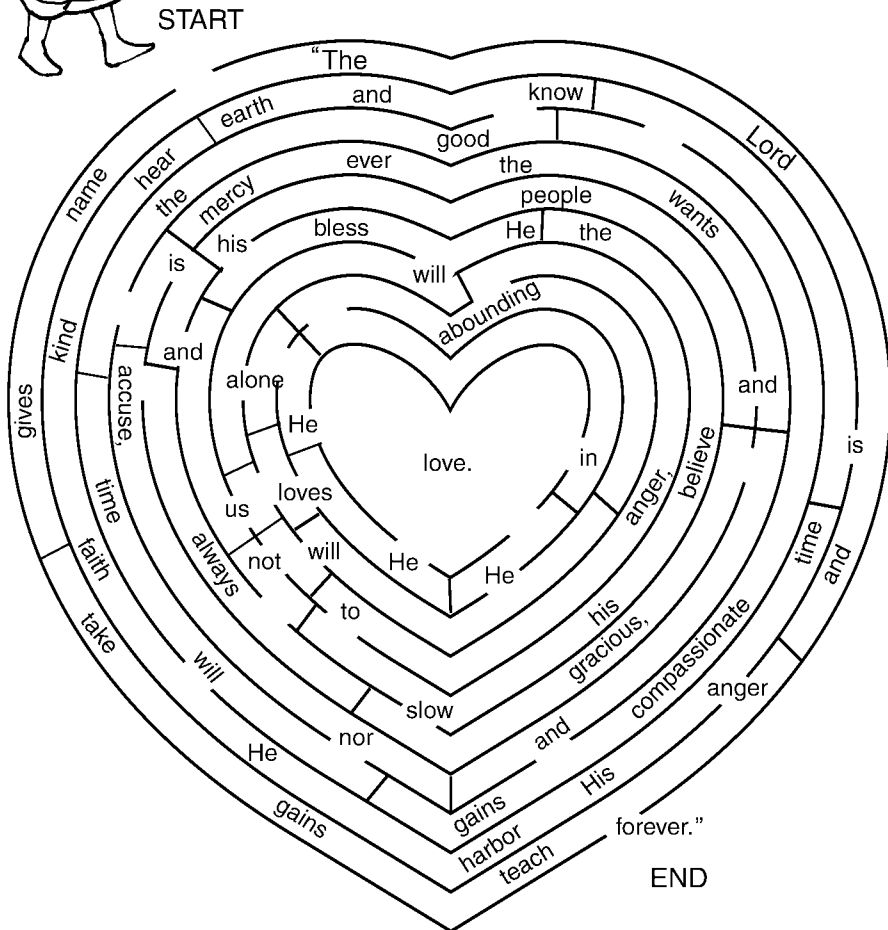
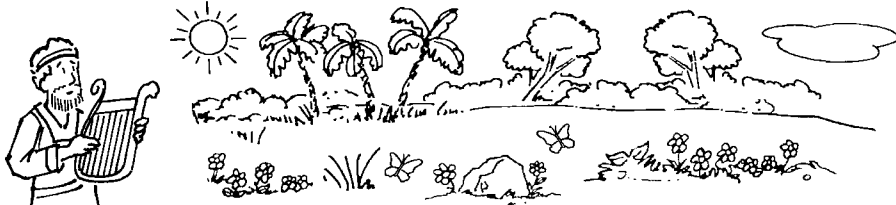

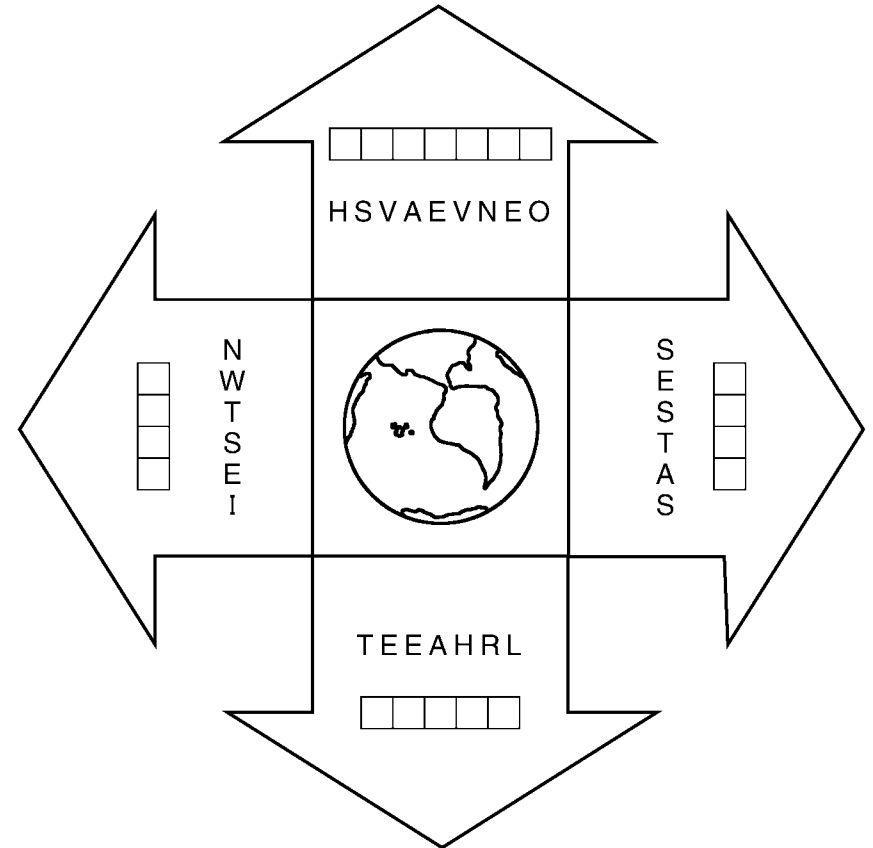
What characteristics of God did the psalmist keep in his mind?
