**Christian Schools Update:** Lacombe Christian School, Ponoka Christian School, Rimbey Christian School and Central Alberta Christian High School have joined a coalition of schools and individuals challenging the constitutionality of recent amendments to the School Act, which mandates the following: Gay Straight and Queer Straight Alliances must be set up at the request of even one student. Parents must not be notified of their child(ren)'s participation in these organizations. Boards and school administrators have no authority in these matters and are required to comply. The Minister of Education has declared that failure post compliant policies will result in a loss of funding as of the 2019/20 school year. We await further communication from Alberta Education and the minister. Please pray for our schools and communities as they face this unprecedented development, and The Justice Centre for Constitutional Freedoms as it prepares our court challenge.
