Pastor's Note/Blog Post:

Resting with God

This is my first Sunday back with you after a three-month Sabbatical Leave (SL). It's good to be back! Now I want to share with you some of the things I learned on the SL. Accordingly, we will begin a sermon series that addresses the three themes/movements of the SL: rest, renew and revisioning. Today we will address the first theme of rest. What does it mean to rest with God? Is it true that God calls us to rest? And what does that rest look like? We will address this theme through the beloved story of Mary and Martha (Luke 10:38-42). One of my prayers today is that as we learn how to rest with God through this story, we will experience the rest of God in the sanctuary. The SL may be technically done. But let us extend it a bit today as we rest with God today and every time we gather in the sanctuary.
