Pastors Note: Introducing our Lenten Sermon Series on Humility

In June 2015 I had the privilege of attending a summer seminar at Calvin College on humility, led by Rev. Cornelius Plantinga, Jr. It was a refreshing study-leave that reflected on a very important topic. Accordingly, I thought it would be beneficial to reflect further on the topic of humility in a sermon series. Lent seemed to be the appropriate time to do this, as it is a season of reflection and worship, which leads us to the cross, where our humble Lord died for us. It is through Christ's humility that we are brought into the kingdom of God—a humbling thought! And now we are called to be Jesus' humble servants, obeying his will and serving others. In this sermon series, I will be guided by a godly teacher, the late Andrew Murray, who wrote extensively on spiritual formation, including the topic of humility. His book, *Humility: The Journey Toward Holiness* is a real gem! I've also found John Dickson's book, *Humilitas* helpful in understanding humility in the context of leadership. So, I invite you to join me on this exploration of humility. My prayer is that as we worship our humble Lord and reflect on his teachings about humility, we will come to know Jesus better as the humble Son of God, and that would we would become the humble loving servants he calls us to be.
