Pastor's Note/Blog Post:

Renewal Through Prayer

This Sunday we will continue our "Sabbatical Leave Sermon Series." Last week we began this journey by talking about rest, which is the first movement of the Sabbatical Leave (SL). Through Luke 10:38-42, we learned that true spiritual (and physical) rest occurs when we sit at Jesus' feet through the reading of/meditation on his Word. This is what Mary did in the gospel story, and we are invited to join her (and Martha) as we rest with Jesus. Now we turn to the second movement of the SL series, which focuses on renewal. After sitting with Jesus through his Word, what happens? We experience the rest of God and are renewed in his presence, which leads us to respond in prayer. It's no accident that Luke follows the "Mary and Martha" story (reading God's Word) with a passage on prayer. So today we will learn how to pray from the master, Jesus himself. So, I invite you to join me in Jesus' "School of Prayer," which is a term I borrow from another prayer master, Andrew Murray. And as we do so, I pray that we will be renewed in our spirits, minds and bodies as we learn about prayer from God's Word and then practice what we learn. Accordingly, we will conduct the Prayers of the People after hearing the Message, as an appropriate response to God's Word, which invites us to pray to our loving Father with boldness. So as always, I look forward to studying God's Word and praying with you.
