Pastor's Note.

This Sunday we resume our sermon series based on the New Testament book of James. In the first sermon in this series, which was based on James 1:2-12, we were challenged to “consider it pure joy . . . whenever you face trials of many kinds, because the testing of your faith produces perseverance.” This is a challenging lesson, to be sure, as we don’t tend to think of trials as an opportunity to grow. But this is the kind of practical faith that James promotes. . . Today we will learn about how to live out our faith in the real world. According to James, a genuine faith in God leads to action—not to earn salvation, but to express and grow it. As James writes, “Faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.” May the Lord increase our faith and make it active as we attend to his Word and seek to apply it to our lives. May we be people who not only hear the word, but do what it says.
